Gallery Grand Opening a Huge Success

It was two days of festivities in August celebrating the official opening of our Arts in Hand gallery, relocated in June from a hard-to-find space to a prime venue at the corner of State Highway 63 and Walnut Street in downtown Spooner.



Fitting that our gallery should be located on 63, as that was the original “Passage” defined in its name. The 1400-square-foot former bank/tavern is transformed, from the original tin ceiling to the hardwood floors and thick concrete walls.

“We are so thrilled to be in this wonderful space,” said Carmella Crandall, Passage vice-president. “It’s a high visibility site, and our customer traffic has increased – probably by 200 percent.”

More than a hundred customers visited the gallery Friday and Saturday the 21st and 22nd, viewing and purchasing the work of three dozen artists representing many of the 13 northwest Wisconsin counties served by WNHP. Comments included “beautiful space,” “didn’t know there were so many talented artists,” “wow, I love it!” Sales were brisk and steady.



Customers enjoyed sandwiches by Pillar’s, an Economart bakery beautifully decorated cake, coffee and wine (alcohol-free) furnished by the gallery. Everyone received a complimentary book-sized logo bag, into which some customers immediately loaded purchases.

The gallery is staffed by volunteers, many of them the artists whose work is shown. Classes and special events are planned throughout the year. The gallery is also a stop on the Fall Splendor Art Meander, September 23-25.
