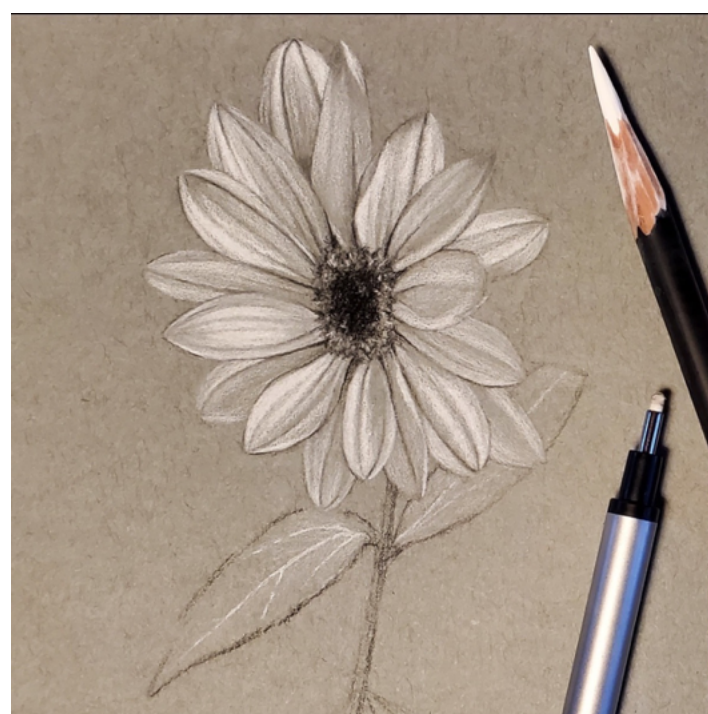


BASICS OF DROP SPINDLING
